PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

- **Disneyland Parking:** Mickey & Friends or Pixar Pals Parking Structures (\$35/day, trams to main entrance, *arrive by 7:30 AM for best spots*).
- Hotel Parking: All recommended hotels offer parking (additional fee, check rates).
- Alternative: Many hotels are walkable. ART shuttle buses and rideshares are convenient for breaks or evening returns.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO DISNEYLAND - THE CLASSICS AWAIT!

MORNING (8:00 AM - 12:00 PM)

8:00 AM: Arrive at Disneyland Park main gates (allow 15-30 min for security).

Breakfast: Market House (Main Street USA) - Starbucks and classic pastries. Mobile order for speed.

8:30 AM: Rope Drop – Head straight to Fantasyland for classic rides with short waits:

- Peter Pan's Flight Iconic, magical, lines build quickly.
- **Dumbo the Flying Elephant** Great for kids, whimsical views.
- King Arthur Carrousel A gentle introduction to Disney magic.

Transportation: If staying offsite, walk or take tram/shuttle from parking.

AFTERNOON (12:00 PM - 6:00 PM)

Lunch: *Plaza Inn (Main Street USA)* – Famous fried chicken, kid's meals, character dining (book in advance). **1:00 PM:** Head to **Adventureland** and **New Orleans Square** for classic attractions:

- Jungle Cruise Fun storytelling for all ages.
- Pirates of the Caribbean Family-friendly, cool escape from the sun.
- Haunted Mansion Mildly spooky, highly themed (kids usually love it).

2:30 PM: Snack break: *Mint Julep Bar* – Try Mickey-shaped beignets.

3:00 PM: Mickey's Toontown – Meet Mickey & Minnie in their houses, explore interactive play areas. **4:30 PM: Parade Viewing** – Secure a Main Street curb spot for the **"Magic Happens" Parade** (exact

times on Disneyland app; usually ~4:45 PM).

EVENING (6:00 PM - 10:00 PM)

Dinner: Red Rose Taverne (Fantasyland) - French-inspired, affordable, kid-friendly.

7:00 PM: Classic attractions with shorter evening waits:

- · It's a Small World
- Mad Tea Party

8:30 PM: Grab a spot in front of Sleeping Beauty Castle for "Wondrous Journeys" Nighttime Spectacular (fireworks, projection mapping, music).

Tip: Use Disneyland app for real-time wait times and mobile food ordering.

End of day: Easy walk or shuttle ride back to hotel.

DAY 2: ADVENTURE & TOMORROW - DISNEY THRILLS AND ICONIC SIGHTS

MORNING (8:00 AM - 12:00 PM)

Breakfast: La Brea Bakery Café (Downtown Disney) - Fresh pastries, sandwiches, quick service.

8:00 AM: Early entry (if staying at Disney hotel). Otherwise, arrive at gates by 7:30 AM.

8:30 AM: Head to Tomorrowland for popular rides before lines build:

- Space Mountain 40"/102cm+, thrill ride (use Genie+ or Lightning Lane if possible).
- Buzz Lightyear Astro Blasters Interactive family fun, no height requirement.
- Star Tours 40"/102cm+, Star Wars-themed simulator.

10:30 AM: Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge – Explore the Millennium Falcon, meet Chewbacca, build a droid (advance reservations for Savi's Workshop and Droid Depot).

AFTERNOON (12:00 PM - 6:00 PM)

Lunch: Docking Bay 7 Food and Cargo (Galaxy's Edge) - Star Wars-themed, creative kid meals.

1:00 PM: Millennium Falcon: Smugglers Run – Height: 38"/97cm+. Family can ride together; single-rider line

available.

2:00 PM: Stroll through Frontierland for:

- Big Thunder Mountain Railroad 40"/102cm+, fun for older kids/adults.
- Mark Twain Riverboat Relaxing scenic ride, all ages.

Snack: Tiki Juice Bar (Adventureland) - Famous Dole Whip.

4:00 PM: Visit **Critter Country** – Try **The Many Adventures of Winnie the Pooh** and browse Pooh Corner shop.

EVENING (6:00 PM - 10:00 PM)

Dinner: Café Orleans (New Orleans Square) – Table service, Cajun classics, kid's menu. Book in advance.

7:30 PM: Fantasmic! (Rivers of America) – Outdoor nighttime show with water effects, fireworks, and Disney characters (check showtimes, arrive early for seating).

Tip: Use Genie+ to reserve attractions and minimize evening waits.

Optional: Explore Main Street shops for souvenirs before heading back to hotel.

DAY 3: DISNEY DETAILS & MAGICAL MEMORIES

MORNING (8:00 AM - 12:00 PM)

Breakfast: *Mickey's Tales of Adventure Breakfast Buffet* (Storytellers Café, Disney's Grand Californian) – Character dining, book early.

8:30 AM: Focus on any favorite rides missed or repeat favorites. Suggested:

- Jungle Cruise or Buzz Lightyear Astro Blasters (usually shorter waits earlier).
- Character Meet-and-Greets Mickey, Minnie, and princesses (locations on Disneyland app).

10:30 AM: Photo ops in front of Sleeping Beauty Castle and the Partners Statue (Walt & Mickey).

AFTERNOON (12:00 PM - 6:00 PM)

Lunch: Alien Pizza Planet (Tomorrowland) - Casual, quick service, pizza and pasta, kid-friendly.

1:00 PM: Explore Fantasyland again for favorites or head to Mickey's Toontown for playtime.

2:30 PM: Disneyland Railroad Grand Circle Tour - Relaxing, scenic loop around the park.

4:00 PM: Wrap up with shopping for souvenirs on Main Street USA.

Tip: Take a midday break at hotel or Baby Care Center if needed (especially with younger kids).

EVENING (6:00 PM - 10:00 PM)

Dinner: Carnation Café (Main Street USA) – American comfort food, charming atmosphere, reservations recommended.

7:30 PM: Enjoy one last round of favorite attractions (many lines are shortest in the late evening).

9:00 PM: Cap off your trip with a final viewing of fireworks or a Main Street farewell.

Return to hotel for a restful night and magical memories!

- Peter Pan's Flight Gentle, magical; no height requirement. Ride first to avoid long lines.
- Dumbo the Flying Elephant Classic; no height requirement.

- The Many Adventures of Winnie the Pooh Gentle dark ride; no height requirement.
- Jungle Cruise Fun narration, animals; no height requirement.
- It's a Small World Colorful, musical boat ride; no height requirement.
- Meet Disney Characters Mickey, Minnie, Princesses at designated locations.

Great for Families & Older Kids (Ages 7+)

- Big Thunder Mountain Railroad Height: 40" (102cm). Family-friendly coaster, best in the afternoon.
- Haunted Mansion Mild spookiness, no height requirement.
- Pirates of the Caribbean Slight drops, fun for all ages; no height requirement.
- Millennium Falcon: Smugglers Run Height: 38" (97cm). Interactive, Star Wars fans love it.
- Space Mountain Height: 40" (102cm). Intense coaster, kids must be comfortable with dark rides.

- Early Arrival Arrive at park gates by 7:30 AM for minimal waits.
- Breaks Use Baby Care Centers (Main Street, Toontown) for quiet breaks, changing, nursing.
