DAY 1: WELCOME TO MAUI & LAHAINA TOWN

MORNING (8:00 AM - 12:00 PM)

Arrive in Maui! Pick up your rental car at Kahului Airport (OGG).

Breakfast: 808 Grindz Café (Lahaina; 45 min drive from airport; free parking nearby) – Local pancakes and kid favorites.

Check-in or drop bags at your hotel.

AFTERNOON (12:00 PM - 6:00 PM)

Explore Historic Lahaina Town \sqcap

- Stroll Front Street's shops and galleries.
- Visit the Banyan Tree Park (great for kids to play; public parking at Wharf St. lot).
- Lahaina Historic Trail: Self-guided walk with plaques—pick up a map at Lahaina Visitor Center.

Lunch: Down the Hatch (casual, kid menu, shaded patio).

Tip: Lahaina can be hot—bring hats and water. Most sights within walking distance.

EVENING (6:00 PM - 10:00 PM)

Sunset Dinner Cruise ☐ (Departs Lahaina Harbor, 2.5 hrs; check-in by 5:30 PM; parking at Harbor lot)

- Pacific Whale Foundation or Trilogy Excursions (book in advance for best rates; child discounts available)
- Dinner included; views of West Maui and neighboring islands.

Alternative Dinner: Kimo's Maui (classic Hawaiian seafood, oceanfront; reservations recommended).

DAY 2: WEST MAUI BEACHES & MARINE LIFE

MORNING (8:00 AM - 12:00 PM)

Beach Day at Ka'anapali Beach ☐ (Free parking at Whalers Village, get validation)

- Swim, build sandcastles, try boogie boarding.
- Walk the scenic Ka'anapali Beachwalk.

Optional: Snorkel at Black Rock (easy entry, sea turtles possible; bring/rent gear).

Breakfast: Island Vintage Coffee (Whalers Village; acai bowls, kid-friendly).

AFTERNOON (12:00 PM - 6:00 PM)

Maui Ocean Center (Ma'alaea, 30 min drive from Ka'anapali)

- Hawaii's top aquarium, interactive exhibits, shark tunnel, tide pools for kids.
- Parking: Free onsite.

Lunch: Seascape Restaurant (at Maui Ocean Center; ocean views, kid's menu).

Tip: Purchase tickets online for timed entry and to skip the line.

EVENING (6:00 PM - 10:00 PM)

Relax at hotel pool or attend a Luau [

- Old Lahaina Luau (Lahaina; book 1-2 months ahead, kid-friendly, buffet & show).
- Alternative: Leilani's on the Beach (Ka'anapali; casual seafood, open-air dining).

Parking: Free at most hotels, or Whalers Village for Ka'anapali restaurants.

DAY 3: ROAD TO HANA ADVENTURE

MORNING (8:00 AM - 12:00 PM)

Embark Early on the Road to Hana ☐ (Leave by 7:30 AM)

- Breakfast: Grab-and-go from hotel or Paia Bay Coffee Bar (Paia, 30 min from Kahului; parking in public lot).
- Begin scenic drive: Twin Falls (easy waterfall hike, kid-friendly, parking \$10).

Tip: Download offline maps; pack snacks, water, towels, change of clothes.

AFTERNOON (12:00 PM - 6:00 PM)

- Stop at Waianapanapa State Park (Black Sand Beach, sea caves; reservation required, book online)
- Quick lunch: Hana Farms Roadside Stand (fresh sandwiches, smoothies, picnic tables).
- Optional: Visit Wai'anapanapa Caves or swim at Hamoa Beach.

Tip: Parking at sights can be limited—arrive early at main stops.

EVENING (6:00 PM - 10:00 PM)

Return to West Maui (Allow 2.5-3 hrs for drive back with breaks).

Dinner: Cane & Canoe (Kapalua; upscale, Hawaiian cuisine, kids welcome; book online).

Alternative: Quick bites in Paia if returning late (Flatbread Company for pizza).

DAY 4: HALEAKALĀ SUNRISE & UPCOUNTRY MAUI

MORNING (3:00 AM - 8:00 AM)

Haleakalā Sunrise (Reserve entry months in advance!)

- Depart hotel by 2:30-3:00 AM (2-2.5 hr drive, dress warmly).
- Parking: Included with sunrise reservation.
- Tip: Kids love the cosmic feel—bring blankets, hot cocoa in thermos.
- After sunrise, stop at Kula Lodge Restaurant for hearty breakfast (opens 7:00 AM; reservations suggested).

AFTERNOON (12:00 PM - 6:00 PM)

Explore Upcountry Farms

- Surfing Goat Dairy (kid-friendly tours, cheese tastings, feed goats; book online).
- Ali'i Kula Lavender Farm (garden walks, scavenger hunts for kids; parking onsite).
- Lunch: Grandma's Coffee House (Kula; casual, local classics, kid menu).
- Tip: Upcountry is cooler—bring a light jacket.

EVENING (6:00 PM - 10:00 PM)

Return to Beach Hotel (1-1.5 hr drive).

Dinner: Duke's Beach House (Ka'anapali; live music, Hawaiian fare, kid-friendly).

- Parking: Free at hotel or Whalers Village.

DAY 5: SNORKELING & IAO VALLEY FINALE

MORNING (8:00 AM - 12:00 PM)

Molokini Snorkel Tour [

- Check-in 6:30-7:00 AM at Ma'alaea Harbor (30 min from Ka'anapali).
- Family-friendly boats: Four Winds II or Pride of Maui (book early for September).
- All gear, breakfast, and kid flotation devices included.

Parking: Paid lot at harbor (\$0.50/hr, arrive early for best spots).

AFTERNOON (12:00 PM - 6:00 PM)

lao Valley State Monument (Wailuku; 40 min drive from Ma'alaea)

- Easy paved path to lao Needle viewpoint (short hike, safe for kids).
- Lunch: Tin Roof Maui (Kahului; casual Hawaiian comfort food, takeout friendly).
- Explore Maui Tropical Plantation (train rides, pond, playground, gift shop; free parking).

EVENING (6:00 PM - 10:00 PM)

Final Dinner: Mama's Fish House (Paia; iconic, oceanfront, fresh catch—book months in advance; valet parking).

Alternative: Paia Fish Market (casual, family-friendly, no reservations). Stroll Paia Town's boutiques before returning to hotel or airport.

Great for Kids (Ages 5-8)

- Maui Ocean Center: Touch pools, shark tunnel, interactive exhibits.
- Ka'anapali Beach: Gentle waves, soft sand, safe swimming, and snorkeling at Black Rock.
- Surfing Goat Dairy: Feed goats, hands-on tours, sample cheeses.
- lao Valley: Short, easy hikes and nature discovery.
- Molokini Snorkel Cruise: Shallow snorkeling, glass-bottom viewing, flotation devices for kids.
- Lahaina Banyan Tree Park: Shady play areas, space to explore.

Family Dining: Nearly all suggested restaurants offer kid menus and high chairs. Luau buffets cater to all ages (with kid-friendly options).

Practical Tips: Stroller-friendly walks at oceanfront resorts, public restrooms at major beaches and attractions, and shaded areas at parks.
